- All locations are licensed by the Maryland State Department of Education for child care.
- Staff/child ratios meet MSDE requirements (1:14 for ages 3+, 1:6 for age 2), in separate groups
- Staffs are fingerprinted for background checks and have CPR/First Aid training.
- Registration fees (non-refundable, annual): \$30, \$20 for siblings.
- Fees (may be tax-deductible as licensed childcare): \$220/week, Siblings: \$200/week
- MSDE Child Care Scholarships are accepted; parent pays the difference, if any.
- Payment is due prior to attending, by credit card, debit card or check: http://fitnessfunandgames.org/payment.html
- Spaces limited. First come, first served, as fees are paid to reserve each week.
- Activities for preschool ages: Stories, arts & crafts, music, games, dramatic play, school readiness such as phonics, math, listening, coordination, social skills and character development.
- Activities for school age include supervision for virtual learning, fitness games outdoors and indoors, arts & crafts, board games, music, and dance.

FFG will follow CDC and MSDE requirements for COVID safety, including but not limited to:

Daily temperature checks recorded for staff and students. No admission for 100.4 degrees +.

Staffs and students wear masks. Six-foot spacing for meals.

Parents wear masks at drop-off and pick-up, which take place at the door.

Children bring their own water bottles and apply sunscreen, first, at home.

Handwashing upon arrival, before and after meals, after using bathroom, and coming in from outside.

Indoor activities are planned to maximize social distancing and minimize shared supplies.

Outdoor activities planned as much as weather permits.

Sanitizing for supplies and for high-touch areas. Sanitizing bathrooms after each group usage.

No field trips, except walks to the outdoor areas of parks.
